4. The student senate will verify your volunteer hours once they are submitted, no later than April 15, 2007

Volunteers will receive:

- An official volunteer presidential service award pin
- A personalized certificate of achievement
- A note of congratulations from the President of the United States
- A letter from the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation
- Students will be recognized at LCCC's Leadership Gala in May 2007
